## School Uniform

### Key stage Three Uniform (Years 7, 8 and 9)

- Year 7, 8 and 9 Light blue polo shirt with school logo
- Navy blue sweatshirt with V-neck with school logo (Years 7, 8 and 9)

### Key Stage Four Uniform (Years 10 and 11)

- Plain white polo shirt with school logo
- Round neck sweatshirt in black or burgundy with school logo
- Dark grey or black long trousers of a traditional school type ('fashion' trousers should not be worn)
- Dark grey or black skirts of approximately knee length
- Black or natural tights, or black, grey or white socks
- Plain cotton apron for technology

### Footwear:

Students should wear comfortable and sensible plain black shoes appropriate for all-day wear in buildings with numerous staircases. We do not consider trainers, plastic, high-heeled or open-toed footwear suitable for a number of reasons and these should not be worn.

### The following are not acceptable for either boys or girls:

- Excessive jewellery. One gold stud, sleeper or small earring per ear is acceptable, but these need to be removed for some activities such as P.E. No other items of body piercing jewellery, such as eyebrow studs, are allowed.
- Excessive make up
- Denim jackets, jeans or shirts
- Camouflage jackets
- Coats decorated with badges, slogans or graffiti
- Extreme hairstyles and colours
